## Water Painting

Grab a paintbrush and a cup of water and make some beautiful, temporary pavement pictures. Paint whatever you want on to the floor using water as your ink and work quickly to finish your masterpiece before it dries and vanishes.



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*Pointillism*



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What you need:

Paint      Cotton bud  
Paper      Pencil

In Pointillism the painting is made up entirely of small dots of pure colour. George Seurat was a famous pointillism painter.

Why not have a go at your own pointillism painting? Start by lightly drawing a picture on a piece of paper and then colour in the picture using a cotton bud and paint to make lots of little dots.

## salt Dough sculptures

1. Mix a cup of plain flour and half a cup of table salt in a bowl.
2. Add half a cup of water mixing until it forms a ball.
3. Move the dough on to a floured surface and shape into your desired model.  
You can roll it out, use objects like forks and sieves to create patterns.  
Experiment with textures to create the effect you want.
4. Put your finished on to a plate and leave in a warm place to dry. This may take several days depending on how thick the dough is.
5. When the model is properly dry you can paint it.



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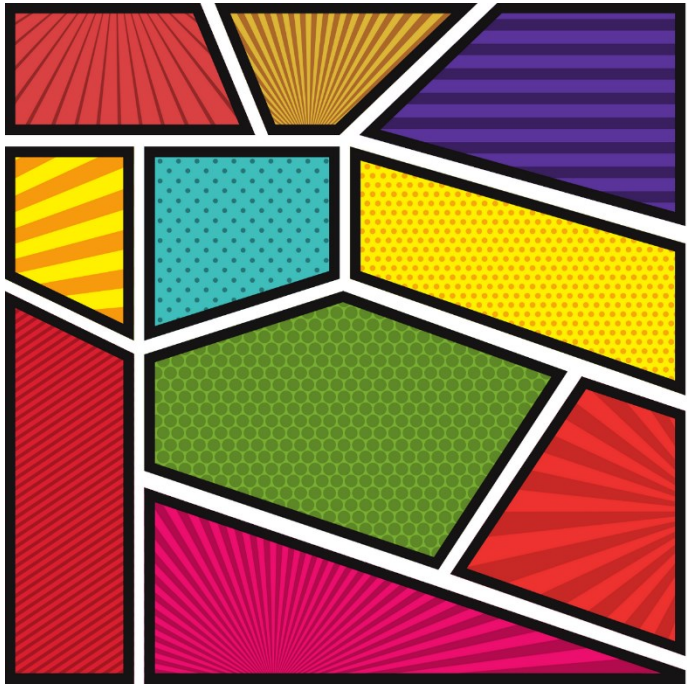
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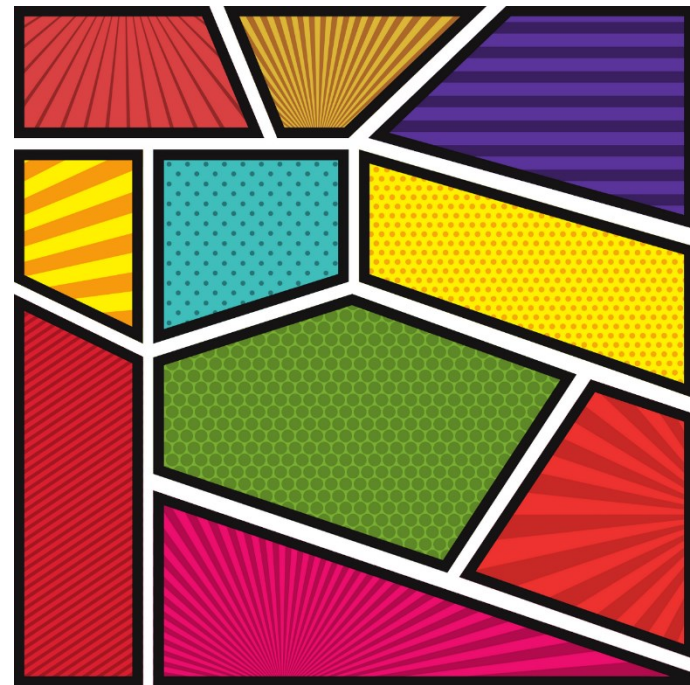

# Flip Book Animation

Flip books work because of an optical illusion. As the images you see move , your eye can't see them individually. So, it only sees one image, which looks like it's moving.

1. On the last page, draw a circle and two eyes. You will make the mouth later.
2. Trace the circle and two eyes on the other pages. These parts will not move.
3. Start making the mouth. First, draw a happy mouth on the last page.
4. Draw the mouth on all the other pages too, but each time make the line flatter, until you get a straight line. Next, make it bend in the reverse direction to form a frown.
5. Flip it forwards or backwards to make your face smile or frown!

Now you've made a simple flip book have a go at making a tricker one. Can you make someone run or jump?

## *Make your own* **MINDFUL COLOURING**

1. Draw 8 circles on a piece of paper, make the circles different sizes.
2. Add details to each circle - petals, patterns or turn them in to something like a hot air balloon.
3. Fill in the gaps between each circle with different lines - wavy ones, diagonal ones and horizontal lines - to create lots of random shapes on the page.
4. When your design is finished you can colour it in.
